

MONTHLY MEETING

February 3, 2004

The Commissioners of Sudlersville held their monthly Town Meeting on Tuesday November 4, 2003. After the Pledge of Allegiance, motions were made, seconded and unanimously approved to accept the minutes, treasurer's reports and budget vs. actual reports as presented.

The repairs at the lagoon requested by Miller Environmental are on hold until the weather warms up.

Dale is working on having the Coleman tract designated a priority funding area. The MD Center for Environmental Training has been asked to help compile specification for bidding the Lagoon Operators job. The pending codification issues will be tabled until Chip MacLeod returns from vacation. The issue of requesting specifications for building a new office has been tabled. \$1,000.00 has been held back from Johnson Construction until warmer weather when he can return and complete grading. A letter was sent to Delegate Sozzi and Senator Pipkin requesting urban renewal authority be granted to Sudlersville.

The Sudlersville Betterment Club submitted an estimate for \$3,000 to fix the little Zoning Office. This issue was tabled until further notice.

After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Wheat, seconded by Commissioner Dulin and unanimously approved to introduce the Friel Annexation Resolution (2004-01) and the Proposed Outline for Extension of Services.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
